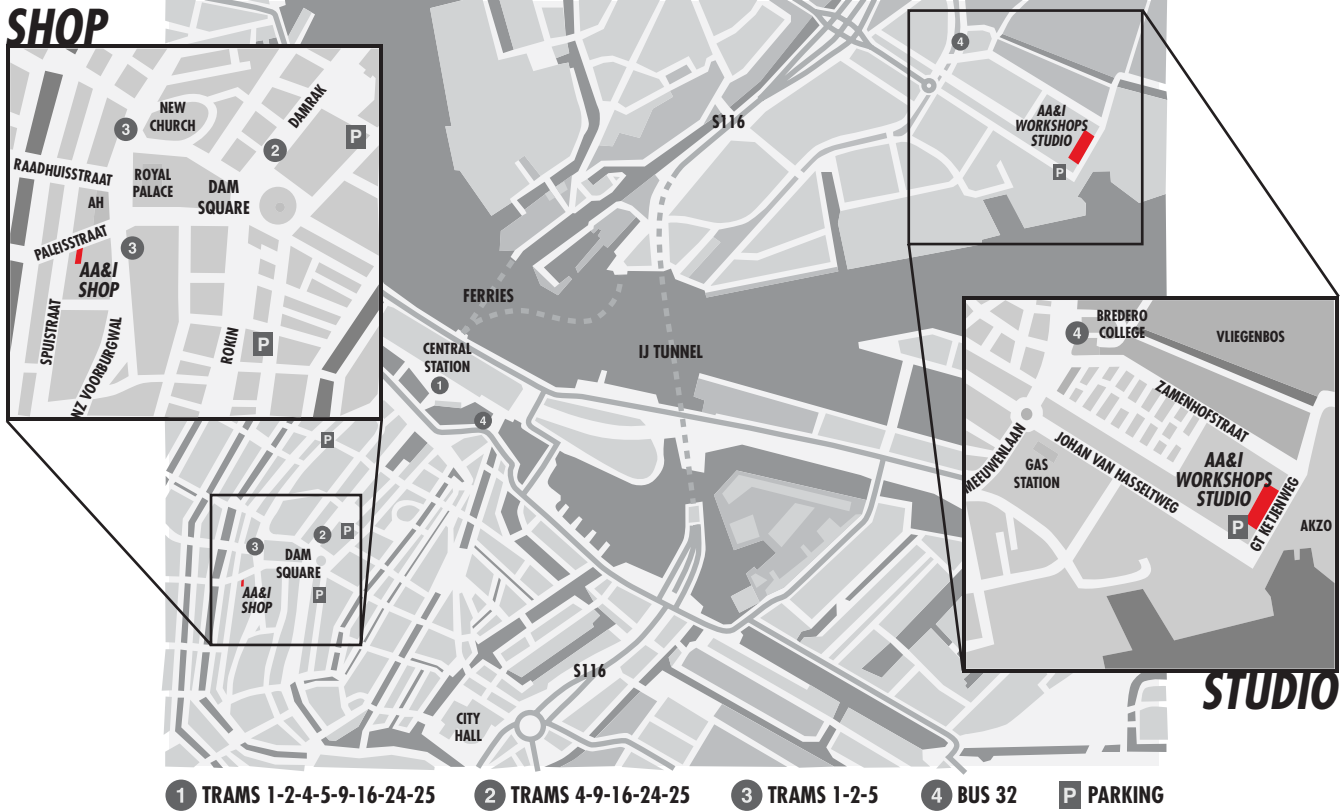

HOW TO GET TO THE ABORIGINAL ART & INSTRUMENTS SHOP

By car from outside the city:

There are several ways to get to the city center when coming from outside Amsterdam. When you enter the Ring (A10), we recommend to take the northern exit S116 Noord towards the IJ-tunnel. Exiting the tunnel, you take a right at the Prins Hendrikkade, drive past the Central Station and turn left at the Nieuwezijds Voorburgwal. After 200 meters there's a parking garage at the Nieuwezijds Kolk, from which it's a 5 minute walk to our store. Walking down the Nieuwezijds Voorburgwal heading towards the city center, the Paleisstraat is at your right after the Albert Heijn supermarket behind the Royal Palace. When taking alternative routes, bear in mind that traffic can be different from what city maps suggest, and parking spots on the canals are not only expensive but also rather hard to find.

By public transport (tram):

From the Central Station you can take a number of trams which will get you to our store. You can either take tram lines 1, 2 or 5, which will go into the Nieuwezijds Voorburgwal. Exit at the third stop (Magna Plaza behind the Dam square) and continue walking in the same direction, and enter the Paleisstraat, the first street on your right, past the Royal Palace and the Albert Heijn supermarket. Alternatively you can take trams 4, 9, 16, 24 and 25, exit at the first stop (Damrak), and walk towards the Dam square. When facing the Royal Palace, there are two small streets on both sides of the Palace. The one on your left is the Paleisstraat, our shop is across the Nieuwezijds Voorburgwal.

HOW TO GET TO THE ABORIGINAL ART & INSTRUMENTS STUDIO (ONLY BY APPOINTMENT!)

By car from outside the city:

Enter the Ring (A10), and take the northern exit S116 Noord. Follow the signs that say 'Centrum - IJ Tunnel', at the traffic lights take the second exit (Noord noord), making a left turn over the viaduct into the Johan van Hasseltweg. At the roundabout go straight ahead, after about 400 meters the road bends to the left into the G.T. Ketjenweg. After about 50 meters you can see a large building on your left hand side, this is Zamenhofstraat 150. We are at unit 101, you will find the entrance and the doorbell at the G.T. Ketjenweg, on the front side of the building under the little rooflet.

By car from inside the city:

Move towards the IJ-Tunnel (S116), enter the tunnel and turn right at the first exit by the traffic lights into the Johan van Hasseltweg. At the roundabout go straight ahead, after about 400 meters the road bends to the left into the G.T. Ketjenweg. After about 50 meters you can see a large building on your left hand side, this is Zamenhofstraat 150. We are at unit 101, you will find the entrance and the doorbell at the G.T. Ketjenweg, on the front side of the building under the little rooflet.

By public transport (bus):

Take bus 32 from the Central Station heading to the Buikslotermeerplein. Another route line 32 takes heads for the KNSM island, so be sure to take the right bus. Exit at the second bus stop ('Zamenhofstraat', this is the first stop after the IJ-Tunnel), walk 50 meters back and take a left turn into the Zamenhofstraat. After 400 meters take a right turn at the T-junction into the G.T. Ketjenweg. After about 50 meters there's a large building at your right hand side, this is Zamenhofstraat 150. We are at unit 101, you will find the entrance and the doorbell at the G.T. Ketjenweg, on the front side of the building under the little rooflet.

By bicycle:

Head for the Central Station and take the rightmost ferry from pier 8, which says 'De Ruyterkade - IJplein'. Once you've arrived at the other side of the IJ, cross the IJplein, enter the Meeuwenlaan and follow the road until the roundabout, then take a right turn into the Johan van Hasseltweg. After about 400 meters this road bends to the left into the G.T. Ketjenweg. After about 50 meters you can see a big building on your left hand side, this is Zamenhofstraat 150. We are at unit 101, you will find the entrance and the doorbell at the G.T. Ketjenweg, on the front side of the building under the little rooflet.
